

Introduction to Encaustic Painting/Beginner Workshop

DESCRIPTION : This 3hr. hands-on class will cover all the basics of working with Encaustic painting. Intro to Encaustics is a comprehensive introduction to working in encaustics, an ancient wax-based paint medium with endless creative possibilities.

Encaustic painting is the process of using melted and pigmented beeswax to create exciting, luminous paintings. If you've ever been curious about encaustics, you're in for a treat! This 3-hr, in person workshop covers a brief history of this ancient medium, the sorts of equipment you'll need, setting up your work space, application of wax to a board achieving a smooth or textured surface, mixing colors, using other substrates such as cardboard and paper, adding other media like paper and thread, working safely with your materials— everything you need to know to start making your own encaustic paintings. All materials are included and all are welcome no matter the level of experience.

Susan Salter, pulling from over 10 years of working with encaustic, leads you step-by-step through the process of creating complex, luminous paintings with hot wax and pigment. You'll get the basic techniques of encaustic under your belt, develop confidence in working with new materials, and walk away with one or more ready-to-hang works.






