A real kaleidoscope uses mirrors to reflect the bits and baubles at the end of the tube. In this demo and workshop, learn how to make two different 2-D kaleidoscope designs.

There is even more to the workshop. Unlock the secrets of hex sign designs as you create your own. Hex refers to the fact that these Pennsylvania Dutch barn signs are based on sixes and not in putting a hex on someone.

Wait! There is even more. Finally, we will explore different ways to create circular and radial art. To finish off your work, you will have opportunity to color in your work with the medium of choice. This is where your designs will really start to shine and show your handy work.
