

Art Class Safety Information Sheet

Please read in full before first class begins to ensure the safety of all participants involved in Art Classes at Fort Bend Art Center.

Social Distancing and Wearing masks will be observed in accordance with Fort Bend Art Center policies.

To ensure the safety of all students involved in art lessons, all participants must follow the following guidelines as well as use common sense and manners.

In case of illness, please call, in advance, to let instructor know at _____.

Materials are never to be placed in the mouth unless specifically directed to do so by the instructor.

Participants must be respectful of others and their work areas and use polite language at all times.

Materials should be treated with care. Any spills should be cleaned up immediately.

All comments will be treated with respect. Positive language and Questions are encouraged.

Participants must stay in the designated class area and not venture into other areas without permission inside or outside.

When allowed to go in other areas, participants should be respectful.

Mistakes are to be treated as opportunities for learning without fear.

Skin is not to be used as a painting surface unless specifically directed to do so.

If students are thirsty, they are allowed to drink water. Bringing their own water bottle is encouraged. Other drinks will not be allowed during class.

Participants should not eat snacks high in sugar before attending class.

Food or drinks (other than water they bring) will not be allowed in class.

Hands are to be washed with soap, wipes, and/or hand sanitizer before and after class.

Parents will be called and student will be removed from class if not adhering to rules.
